"578.007. The provisions of section 574.130[5] and sections 578.005 to 578.023 shall not
apply to:  (1) Care or treatment performed by a licensed veterinarian within the provisions of chapter
340; (2) Page fide exicutific experiments:

privileges as allowed under the Missouri Wildlife Code;
