1 AMEND House Amendment No. \_\_\_\_ to Senate Bill No. 8, Page 2, Line 15, by inserting  
2 immediately after said line the following:

4 "Further amend said bill, Page 2, Section 307.175, Line 23, by inserting immediately after  
5 said section and line the following:

7 "574.010. 1. A person commits the offense of peace disturbance if he or she:

8 (1) Unreasonably and knowingly disturbs or alarms another person or persons by:

9 (a) Loud noise; or

10 (b) Offensive language addressed in a face-to-face manner to a specific individual and  
11 uttered under circumstances which are likely to produce an immediate violent response from a  
12 reasonable recipient; or

13 (c) Threatening to commit a felonious act against any person under circumstances which are  
14 likely to cause a reasonable person to fear that such threat may be carried out; or

15 (d) Fighting; or

16 (e) Creating a noxious and offensive odor;

17 (2) Is in a public place or on private property of another without consent and purposely  
18 causes inconvenience to another person or persons by unreasonably and physically obstructing:

19 (a) Vehicular or pedestrian traffic; or

20 (b) The free ingress or egress to or from a public or private place.

21 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of subsection 1 of this section, a person  
22 does not commit the offense of peace disturbance by creating a loud noise or creating a noxious or  
23 offensive odor if such alleged noise or odor arises from or is attendant to:

24 (a) Raising, maintaining, or keeping livestock as defined in section 277.020 including, but  
25 not limited to, any noise or odor made directly by or coming directly from any livestock;

26 (b) Planting, caring for, maintaining, or harvesting crops or hay; or

27 (c) The engine of a vehicle or tractor while engaged in normal business related activities.

28 3. The offense of peace disturbance is a class B misdemeanor upon the first conviction.  
29 Upon a second or subsequent conviction, peace disturbance is a class A misdemeanor. Upon a third  
30 or subsequent conviction, a person shall be sentenced to pay a fine of no less than one thousand  
31 dollars and no more than five thousand dollars."; and"; and
