1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 112, Page 47, Section 347.048, Line 18, by inserting immediately after all of said section and line the 2 3 following: 4 5 "451.090. 1. No recorder shall, in any event except as herein provided, issue a license 6 authorizing the marriage of any person under [fifteen] seventeen years of age; provided, however, 7 that such license may be issued on order of a circuit or associate circuit judge of the county in which 8 the license is applied for, such license being issued only [for good cause shown and by reason of 9 such unusual conditions as to] after a hearing has been held in which the parties present evidence to the court that would make such marriage advisable. The court, in its order, shall determine that 10 11 there is no evidence of coercion or abuse of either person entering the marriage. 12 2. No recorder shall issue a license authorizing the marriage of any male under the age of 13 eighteen years or of any female under the age of eighteen years, except with the consent of his or 14 her custodial parent or guardian, which consent shall be given at the time, in writing, stating the 15 residence of the person giving such consent, signed and sworn to before an officer authorized to 16 administer oaths. In no instance shall a license be issued authorizing the marriage of any male or female twenty-one years of age or older if the other party to the marriage is less than seventeen 17 18 years of age. 19 3. The recorder shall state in every license whether the parties applying for same, one or 20 either or both of them, are of age, or whether the male is under the age of eighteen years or the female under the age of eighteen years, and if the male is under the age of eighteen years or the 21 22 female is under the age of eighteen years, the name of the custodial parent or guardian consenting to such marriage. Applicants shall provide proof of age to the recorder in the form of a certified copy 23 24 of the applicant's birth certificate, the applicant's passport, or other government-issued identification, which shall then be documented by the recorder."; and 25 26 27 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references

accordingly.
