1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 29, Page 3, Section 311.188, Line 3, by 2 inserting immediately after all of said line the following: 3 4 "311.510. 1. It shall be the duty of the supervisor of liquor control to cause to be inspected 5 all beer, as defined in this chapter, or other intoxicating malt liquors, brewed, manufactured or sold 6 in this state, and he or she shall determine whether such beer or other intoxicating malt liquor has 7 been made from pure hops or the pure extract of hops, or of pure barley malt or other wholesome 8 grains or cereals, or wholesome yeast, and pure water, and whether the package containing such 9 beer or intoxicating malt liquor has been correctly labeled to show that the same has been made from wholesome ingredients. 10 11 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, the supervisor of liquor 12 control shall not require product samples and shall not require the testing of product samples to determine alcohol content prior to granting approval for the sale of any such beer or other 13 14 intoxicating malt liquor product in the state of Missouri if the supervisor of liquor control is 15 provided with a copy of a certificate of label approval issued by the [Federal Bureau of Alcohol, 16 Tobacco and Firearms] Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau which verifies the alcohol 17 content of the product. 18 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, the supervisor of liquor 19 control shall not require product samples prior to granting approval for the sale of any beer or other 20 intoxicating malt liquors brewed, manufactured, and sold exclusively in this state if the supervisor of liquor control is provided a label and the results of a test of a product sample to confirm the 21 22 alcohol content. The supervisor of liquor control shall have sole authority to approve all labels for keg collars, bottles, and cans of such beer or other intoxicating malt liquor and any inspections to 23 24 determine labeling compliance for such products shall be under the sole authority of the supervisor of liquor control, with no approval or inspection by the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau 25 required."; and 26 27 28 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
