2	inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4	"311.179. 1. Any person possessing the qualifications and meeting the requirements of this
5	chapter who is licensed to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail in an international airport
6	located in a county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty
7	thousand inhabitants or in a county of the first classification with more than eighty-three thousand
8	but fewer than ninety-two thousand inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with more
9	than four thousand five hundred but fewer than five thousand inhabitants as the county seat may
10	apply to the supervisor of [liquor control] alcohol and tobacco control for a special permit[. The
11	permit shall allow] which:
12	(1) Allows the premises located in the international airport in such county to open at 4 a.m.
13	and sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption [on the premises where sold]. The
14	provisions of this section and not those of section 311.097 regarding the time of opening shall apply
15	to the sale of intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption [on the premises where sold]
16	on Sunday[.];
17	(2) Allows persons to leave licensed establishments with an alcoholic beverage and enter
18	other airport designated areas located within such airport. No person shall take any alcoholic
19	beverage or beverages outside such designated areas, including onto any airplane; and
20	(3) Requires every licensee within such international airport to serve alcoholic beverages in
21	containers that display and contain the licensee's trade name or logo or some other mark that is
22	unique to that license and licensee.
23	2. An applicant granted a special permit pursuant to this section shall, in addition to all
24	other fees required by this chapter, pay an additional fee of three hundred dollars a year payable at
25	the time and in the same manner as its other license fees."; and

27	Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
28	accordingly.
