1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 95, Page 2, Section 50.622, Line 22, by  
2 inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "67.1364. 1. Upon adoption of the tourism sales tax, there shall be established a tourism  
5 commission to consist of five members appointed by the governing body of the city or county. Of  
6 these five members, one will be a representative of the hotel and motel industry and two shall be  
7 active in the tourism industry; the remaining members of the commission will be members of local  
8 general business interests in the city or county. One member of the city or county governing body  
9 shall serve as liaison in a nonvoting capacity. If members of a tourism commission are appointed by  
10 the governing body of a city, all members shall be a resident of the city or county in which any part  
11 of the city is located. If members of a tourism commission are appointed by the governing body of  
12 a county, all members shall be a resident of such county. Members of the tourism commission will  
13 be appointed for a term of three years; but, of the members first appointed, one shall be appointed  
14 for a term of one year, two shall be appointed for a term of two years, and two shall be appointed  
15 for a term of three years. Members of the commission may serve no more than two consecutive  
16 terms. The members will serve without compensation.

17 2. The revenue received from the tax shall be deposited in a special fund and used solely to  
18 promote tourism. The commission shall administer the moneys within the limits of the budget  
19 approved by the city or county governing body."; and

21 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
22 accordingly.
