1 AMEND House Bill No. 426, Pages 3-4, Section 287.243, Lines 77-89, by deleting all of said lines
2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "(1) To the surviving spouse of the law enforcement officer, emergency medical technician,
5 air ambulance pilot, air ambulance registered professional nurse, or firefighter if there is no child
6 who survived the law enforcement officer, emergency medical technician, air ambulance pilot, air
7 ambulance registered professional nurse, or firefighter;

8 (2) Fifty percent to the surviving child (or children, in equal shares) and fifty percent to the
9 surviving spouse if there is at least one child who survived the law enforcement officer, emergency
10 medical technician, air ambulance pilot, air ambulance registered professional nurse, or firefighter,
11 and a surviving spouse of the law enforcement officer, emergency medical technician, air ambulance
12 pilot, air ambulance registered professional nurse, or firefighter;

13 (3) To the surviving child (or children, in equal shares) if there is no surviving spouse of the
14 law enforcement officer, emergency medical technician, air ambulance pilot, air ambulance
15 registered professional nurse, or firefighter;"; and

17 Further amend said bill and section, Page 4, Lines 100-113, by deleting all of said lines and
18 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

20 "(b) To the surviving individual (or individuals, in equal shares) designated by the law
21 enforcement officer, emergency medical technician, air ambulance pilot, air ambulance registered
22 professional nurse, or firefighter to receive benefits under the most recently executed life insurance
23 policy of the law enforcement officer, emergency medical technician, air ambulance pilot, air
24 ambulance registered professional nurse, or firefighter on file at the time of death with the public
25 safety agency, organization, or unit if there is no individual qualifying under paragraph (a);

26 (5) To the surviving parent (or parents, in equal shares) of the law enforcement officer,
27 emergency medical technician, air ambulance pilot, air ambulance registered professional nurse, or
28 firefighter if there is no individual qualifying under subdivisions (1), (2), (3), or (4) of this
29 subsection, ; or

30 (6) To the surviving individual (or individuals, in equal shares) who would qualify under
31 the definition of the term "child" but for age if there is no individual qualifying under subdivision
32 (1), (2), (3), (4), or (5) of this subsection."; and

34 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
35 accordingly.
