AMEND House Amendment No. to House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for 1 2 Senate Bill No. 62, Page 1, Line 8, by inserting after all of said line the following: 3 4 "Further amend said bill, Page 2, Section 52.290, Line 27, by inserting after all of said line the 5 following: 6 7 "86.207. 1. Except as provided herein, all persons who become policemen and all 8 policemen who enter or reenter the service of any city not within a county after the first day of 9 October, 1957, become members of the system as a condition of their employment and during the 10 period of their membership shall receive no pensions or retirement allowance from any other pension or retirement system supported wholly or in part by the city not within a county or the state 11 12 of Missouri, nor shall they be required to make contributions under any other pension or retirement system of the city not within a county or the state of Missouri for the same period of service, 13 14 anything to the contrary notwithstanding. Any employee of a city not within a county who is earning creditable service in a retirement plan established by said city under section 95.540 and 15 16 subsequently becomes a policeman may elect to remain a member of said retirement plan and shall 17 not be required to become a member of a police retirement system established under section 86.200. However,]. Officers employed by a city not within a county and occupying the position of "Airport 18 19 Police Officer" shall not be required to become members as a condition of their employment. An 20 employee of a city not within a county who is earning creditable service in a retirement plan 21 established by said city under section 95.540 and who subsequently becomes a policeman may elect 22 to transfer [membership and] creditable service to the police retirement system created under [section] sections 86.200 to 86.366. Such transfers are subject to the conditions and requirements 23 24 contained in section 105.691 and are also subject to any existing agreements between the said 25 retirement plans[; provided however, transfers completed prior to January 1, 2016, shall occur without regard to the vesting requirements of the receiving plan contained in section 105.691]. As 26 part of the transfer process described herein, the respective retirement plans may require the 27 28 employee to acknowledge and agree as a condition of transfer that any election made under this section is irrevocable, constitutes a waiver of any right to receive retirement and disability benefits 29 30 except as provided by the police retirement system, and that plan terms may be modified in the 31 future.

32 2. If any member ceases to be in service for more than one year unless the member has
 33 attained the age of fifty-five or has twenty years or more of creditable service, or if the member

- 1 withdraws the member's accumulated contributions or if the member receives benefits under the

- actually retired and is receiving retirement benefits under the system shall be considered a retired
 member.
