1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 30, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by
2 inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "54.261. 1. The county treasurer in counties of the first classification, not having a charter
5 form of government and containing a portion of a city with a population of three hundred thousand
6 or more, and in counties of the second, third and fourth classifications of this state, shall receive as
7 compensation for services performed by the treasurer an annual salary based upon the assessed
8 valuation of the county. The provisions of this section shall not permit or require a reduction, nor
9 shall require an increase, in the amount of compensation being paid for the office of treasurer on
10 January 1, 2002.

11 2. The amount of salary based upon assessed valuation shall be computed according to the
12 following schedule:

66,000,000 to 85,999,999	34,000

25 3. Two thousand dollars of the salary authorized in this section shall be payable to the
26 treasurer only if the treasurer has completed at least twenty hours of classroom instruction each
27 calendar year relating to the operations of the treasurer's office when approved by a professional
28 association of the county treasurers or county collectors of Missouri unless exempted from the
29 training by the professional association. The professional association approving the program shall
30 provide a certificate of completion to each treasurer who completes the training program and shall
31 send a list of certified treasurers to the county commission of each county. Expenses incurred for
32 attending the training session ~~may~~ shall be reimbursed to the county treasurer in the same manner
33 as other expenses as may be appropriated for that purpose.

34 4. The county treasurer in any county, other than a county of the first classification having a
35 charter form of government or a county of the first classification not having a charter form of
36 government and not containing any part of a city with a population of three hundred thousand or

1 more, shall not, except upon two-thirds vote of all the members of the commission, receive an
2 annual compensation in an amount less than the total compensation being received for the office of
3 county treasurer in the particular county for services rendered or performed on the date the salary
4 commission votes.

5 5. In the event of a vacancy due to death, resignation, or otherwise in the office of treasurer
6 in any county except a county with a charter form of government, and when there is no deputy
7 treasurer, the county commission shall appoint a qualified acting treasurer until such time as the
8 vacancy is filled by the governor pursuant to section 105.030 or the elected treasurer returns to
9 work. The county commission shall employ and fix the compensation of clerical and other
10 assistants necessary to enable the interim treasurer to efficiently perform the duties of the office.";
