1 AMEND Senate Committee Substitute No. 2 for Senate Bill No. 128, Page 1, Section 478.463, Line
2 9, by inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "488.2206. 1. In addition to all court fees and costs prescribed by law, a surcharge of up to
5 ten dollars shall be assessed as costs in each court proceeding filed in any court within [~~the thirty-~~
6 ~~first judicial circuit~~] any judicial circuit composed of a single noncharter county in all civil and
7 criminal cases including violations of any county or municipal ordinance or any violation of a
8 criminal or traffic law of the state, including an infraction, except that no such surcharge shall be
9 collected in any proceeding in any court when the proceeding or defendant has been dismissed by
10 the court or when costs are to be paid by the state, county, or municipality. For violations of the
11 general criminal laws of the state or county ordinances, no such surcharge shall be collected unless
12 it is authorized, by order, ordinance, or resolution by the county government where the violation
13 occurred. For violations of municipal ordinances, no such surcharge shall be collected unless it is
14 authorized by order, ordinance, or resolution by the municipal government where the violation
15 occurred. Such surcharges shall be collected and disbursed by the clerk of each respective court
16 responsible for collecting court costs in the manner provided by sections 488.010 to 488.020, and
17 shall be payable to the treasurer of the political subdivision authorizing such surcharge, who shall
18 deposit the funds in a separate account known as the "justice center fund", to be established and
19 maintained by the political subdivision.

20 2. Each county or municipality shall use all funds received pursuant to this section only to
21 pay for the costs associated with the land assemblage and purchase, planning, construction,
22 maintenance, and operation of any county or municipal judicial facility or justice center including,
23 but not limited to, architectural, engineering, and other plans and studies, debt service, utilities,
24 maintenance, and building security. The county or municipality shall maintain records identifying
25 [such operating costs, and any moneys not needed for the operating costs of the county or municipal
26 judicial facility shall be transmitted quarterly to the general revenue fund of the county or
27 municipality respectively] all funds received and expenditures made from their respective center
28 funds."; and

30 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
