9	Further said amendment, Page 5, Lines 42-48, and Page 6, Lines 1-2, by deleting all of said lines
10	and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12	"(4) "Lodging establishment", any building, group of buildings, structure, facility, place, or
13	places of business where five or more guest rooms are provided separately and independently,
14	which is owned, maintained, or operated by any person and which is kept, used, maintained,
15	advertised or held out to the public for hire which can be construed to be a hotel, motel, motor hotel,
16	apartment hotel, tourist court, resort, cabins, [tourist home,] bunkhouse, dormitory, or other similar
17	place by whatever name called, and includes all such accommodations operated for hire as lodging
18	establishments for either transient guests, permanent guests, or for both transient and permanent
19	guests. Lodging establishment shall not include any property classified as residential property for
20	real property taxation purposes;"; and

22	Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
23	accordingly.
