1 AMEND House Bill No. 301, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting immediately after all of said
2 section and line the following:

4 "217.243. 1. Any inmate who receives an on-site nonemergency medical examination or
5 treatment from the correctional center's medical personnel shall be assessed a charge of fifty cents
6 per visit for the medical examination or treatment.

7 2. Inmates shall be charged a co-pay fee except for the following:

8 (1) Health care services based on staff referrals;

9 (2) Staff-approved follow-up treatment for chronic illnesses;

10 (3) Preventive health care;

11 (4) Emergency services;

12 (5) Prenatal care;

13 (6) Diagnosis or treatment of chronic infectious diseases;

14 (7) Mental health care; or

15 (8) Substance abuse treatment.

16 3. Inmates without funds shall not be charged, provided they are considered to be indigent
17 and are unable to pay the health care services fee.

18 4. The department may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section. Any
19 rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the
20 authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to
21 all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter
22 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter
23 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
24 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after
25 August 28, 2017, shall be invalid and void."; and
