1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 302, Page 3, Section 68.075, Line 53, by
2 inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "86.207. 1. Except as provided herein, all persons who become policemen and all
4 policemen who enter or reenter the service of any city not within a county after the first day of
5 October, 1957, become members of the system as a condition of their employment and during the
6 period of their membership shall receive no pensions or retirement allowance from any other
7 pension or retirement system supported wholly or in part by the city not within a county or the state
8 of Missouri, nor shall they be required to make contributions under any other pension or retirement
9 system of the city not within a county or the state of Missouri for the same period of service[;
10 ~~anything to the contrary notwithstanding. Any employee of a city not within a county who is~~
11 ~~earning creditable service in a retirement plan established by said city under section 95.540 and~~
12 ~~subsequently becomes a policeman may elect to remain a member of said retirement plan and shall~~
13 ~~not be required to become a member of a police retirement system established under section 86.200.~~
14 ~~However,]~~ Officers employed by a city not within a county and occupying the position of "Airport
15 Police Officer" shall not be required to become members as a condition of their employment. An
16 employee of a city not within a county who is earning creditable service in a retirement plan
17 established by said city under section 95.540 and who subsequently becomes a policeman may elect
18 to transfer [membership and] creditable service to the police retirement system created under
19 [section] sections 86.200 to 86.366. Such transfers are subject to the conditions and requirements
20 contained in section 105.691 and are also subject to any existing agreements between the said
21 retirement plans[; provided however, transfers completed prior to January 1, 2016, shall occur
22 without regard to the vesting requirements of the receiving plan contained in section 105.691]. As
23 part of the transfer process described herein, the respective retirement plans may require the
24 employee to acknowledge and agree as a condition of transfer that any election made under this
25 section is irrevocable, constitutes a waiver of any right to receive retirement and disability benefits
26 except as provided by the police retirement system, and that plan terms may be modified in the
27 future.

28 2. If any member ceases to be in service for more than one year unless the member has
29 attained the age of fifty-five or has twenty years or more of creditable service, or if the member
30 withdraws the member's accumulated contributions or if the member receives benefits under the
31 retirement system or dies, the member thereupon ceases to be a member; except in the case of a
32 member who has served in the Armed Forces of the United States and has subsequently been
33 reinstated as a policeman. A member who has terminated employment as a police officer, has
34 actually retired and is receiving retirement benefits under the system shall be considered a retired
35 member.

36 3. A reserve officer shall not be considered a member of the system for the purpose of

1 determining creditable service, nor shall any contributions be due. A reserve officer shall not be
2 entitled to any benefits from the system other than those awarded when the reserve officer originally
3 retired under section 86.250, nor shall service as a reserve officer prohibit distribution of those
4 benefits."; and

6 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 135.963, Line 54, by inserting after all of said line the
7 following:

8 "Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to meet the requirements of the Social
9 Security Administration and to prevent the expulsion of Missouri airport officers from the Social
10 Security Program, section 86.207 of section A of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate
11 preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an
12 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section 86.207 of section A of this act
13 shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; and

15 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
16 accordingly.
