1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 302, Page 3, Section 68.075, Line 53, by
2 inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "84.514. The chief of police, with the approval of the board, may appoint a police officer to
5 serve as lieutenant colonel on matters relating to homeland security. Notwithstanding the provisions
6 of section 84.510 to the contrary, such position shall be a new position and in addition to the number
7 of lieutenant colonels authorized under section 84.510. The lieutenant colonel authorized under this
8 section shall be responsible for matters relating to homeland security as determined by the chief and
9 be entitled to the same rank, privileges, and compensation afforded all other lieutenant colonels
10 within the department."; and

11
12 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 135.963, Line 54, by inserting immediately after all of said
13 section and line the following:

15 "Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to allow the sheriff to appoint deputies
16 as expeditiously as possible for efficient performance of the position, the repeal of sections 57.010,
17 57.530, 57.452, and 57.475 and reenactment of sections 57.010 and 57.530 of section A of this act
18 are deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and
19 safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and the
20 repeal of sections 57.010, 57.530, 57.452, and 57.475 and reenactment of sections 57.010 and
21 57.530 of section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
24 accordingly.
