1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 908 & 757, Page 7, Section 188.027,  
2 Line 204, by inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "188.052. 1. An individual abortion report for each abortion performed or induced upon a  
5 woman shall be completed by her attending physician. The report shall include:

6 (1) Information required by the United States Standard Report of Induced Termination of  
7 Pregnancy published by the National Center for Health Statistics, Centers for Disease Control and  
8 Prevention within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, or its successor publication  
9 or agency;

10 (2) Additional information on the type of abortion procedure used, including the specific  
11 surgical or nonsurgical method or the specific abortion-inducing drug or drugs employed including,  
12 but not limited to, vacuum aspiration, suction curettage, sharp curettage, dilation and evacuation  
13 (D&E), intact D&E, dilation and extraction (D&X), intrauterine saline instillation, intrauterine  
14 prostaglandin instillation, hysterotomy, methotrexate, mifepristone, or misoprostol; and

15 (3) If provided by the woman, the reason or reasons the woman sought the abortion,  
16 including specific medical, social, economic, or other factors including, but not limited to, particular  
17 health conditions, pregnancy resulting from rape or incest, not wanting other persons to know of her  
18 pregnancy, other persons objecting to her pregnancy, relationship problems with the father of the  
19 child or other family members, lack of financial support from the father of the child, disruption of  
20 education or job, or desire to limit family size.

21 2. An individual complication report for any post-abortion care performed upon a woman  
22 shall be completed by the physician providing such post-abortion care. This report shall include,  
23 but not be limited to:

24 (1) The date of the abortion;

25 (2) The name and address of the abortion facility or hospital where the abortion was  
26 performed;

27 (3) The nature of the abortion complication diagnosed or treated.

28 3. All abortion reports shall be signed by the attending physician, and submitted to the [state  
29 ~~department of health and senior services~~] department within forty-five days from the date of the  
30 abortion. All complication reports shall be signed by the physician providing the post-abortion care  
31 and submitted to the department [~~of health and senior services~~] within forty-five days from the date  
32 of the post-abortion care.

33 4. A copy of the abortion report shall be made a part of the medical record of the patient of  
34 the facility or hospital in which the abortion was performed.

35 5. The [~~state department of health and senior services~~] department shall be responsible for  
36 collecting all abortion reports and complication reports and collating and evaluating all data

1 gathered therefrom and shall annually publish a statistical report based on such data from abortions  
 2 performed or induced and post-abortion care provided in the previous calendar year. The report  
 3 shall specify the gestational age, by weekly increments, at which abortions were performed or  
 4 induced, but the report shall not include any information that would allow the public to identify a  
 5 specific:

6 (1) Patient who obtained an abortion or who received post-abortion care;

7 (2) Physician who performed or induced an abortion or who provided post-abortion care; or

8 (3) Hospital or abortion facility where the abortion was performed or induced or which  
 9 provided post-abortion care.

10 188.055. 1. Every abortion facility, hospital, and physician shall be supplied with forms by  
 11 the department ~~[of health and senior services]~~ for use in regards to the consents and reports required  
 12 by sections 188.010 to 188.085. A purpose and function of such consents and reports shall be the  
 13 preservation of maternal health and life by adding to the sum of medical knowledge through the  
 14 compilation of relevant maternal health and life data and to monitor all abortions performed to  
 15 assure that they are done only under and in accordance with the provisions of the law.

16 2. All information obtained by physician, hospital, or abortion facility from a patient for the  
 17 purpose of preparing reports to the department ~~[of health and senior services]~~ under sections  
 18 188.010 to 188.085 or reports received by the ~~[division of health]~~ department shall be confidential  
 19 and shall be used only for statistical purposes. Such records, however, may be inspected and health  
 20 data acquired by local, state, or national public health officers.

21 188.070. Any ~~[physician or other person who fails to maintain]~~ person who knowingly  
 22 violates the confidentiality of any records [or reports required], reports, or documents maintained by  
 23 the hospital or abortion facility or received by the department under sections 188.010 to 188.085 is  
 24 guilty of a ~~[misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished as provided by law]~~ class D  
 25 felony."; and
