1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 576, Pages 1-2, Section 302.020, Lines
2 19-23, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3
4 "of this state shall wear protective headgear at all times the vehicle is in motion. Every
5 person twenty-one years of age or older operating any motorcycle or motortricycle who has been
6 issued an instruction permit shall wear protective headgear at all times the vehicle is in motion.
7 Every person twenty-one years of age or older operating any motorcycle or motortricycle who has
8 neither possessed his or her motorcycle license or motorcycle endorsement for a minimum period of
9 two years nor completed a motorcycle safety education course approved pursuant to sections
10 302.133 to 302.137 shall wear"; and

11
12 Further amend said bill and section, Page 2, Lines 25-26, by deleting "twenty-one years of age or
13 older"; and

14
15 Further amend said bill and page, Section 302.026, Line 13, by inserting immediately after all of
16 said section and line the following:

18 "304.005. 1. As used in this section, the term "autocycle" means a three-wheeled motor
19 vehicle [on] which the drivers and passengers ride in a partially or completely enclosed[, tandem]
20 non-straddle seating area [that is equipped with air bag protection, a roll cage, safety belts for each
21 occupant, and antilock brakes and], that is designed to be controlled with a steering wheel and
22 pedals, and that has met applicable Department of Transportation National Highway Traffic Safety
23 Administration requirements or Federal Motorcycle Safety Standards.

24 2. Notwithstanding subsection 2 of section 302.020, a person operating or riding in an
25 autocycle shall not be required to wear protective headgear if the vehicle is equipped with a roof
26 that meets or exceeds the standards established for protective headgear.

27 3. No person shall operate an autocycle on any highway or street in this state unless the
28 person has a valid driver's license. The operator of an autocycle, however, shall not be required to
29 obtain a motorcycle or motortricycle license or endorsement pursuant to sections 302.010 to
30 302.340."; and

32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
33 accordingly.
