1 AMEND House Bill No. 889, Page 3, Section 610.100, Lines 57 to 85, by removing all of said lines
2 from the bill and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "4. (1) Except as authorized by this section or any other law or rule for purposes including
5 administrative necessities, court adjudications, or law enforcement, any portion of a record or
6 document of a law enforcement agency or officer that contains identifying information about the
7 victim of a rape, sexual assault, or any other sexual offense under chapter 566, shall not be subject
8 to disclosure under this section.

9 (2) An individual who is the subject of a report of attempted suicide, or such individual's
10 parent or guardian if the individual is a minor or incapacitated, may obtain a complete unaltered and
11 unedited incident report concerning the incident, and may obtain access to other records closed by a
12 law enforcement agency under this section. If a suicide did occur, then such records shall be
13 released to the victim's familial relations within the second degree of consanguinity or affinity upon
14 request. An individual who is the reported victim of rape, sexual assault, or any other sexual
15 offense under chapter 566, or his or her parent or guardian if the individual is a minor or
16 incapacitated, may obtain a complete unaltered and unedited incident report concerning the incident,
17 and may obtain access to other records closed by a law enforcement agency under this section. A
18 law enforcement agency may release any information from reports involving suicide or attempted
19 suicide, upon its own volition and without the consent of the individual who is the reported victim
20 of any such act, if the release of such information is immediately necessary to the preservation of
21 the health and safety of an individual or the public health and welfare."; and

23 Further amend said bill, Page 6, Section 610.200, Lines 15 to 18, by removing all of said lines from
24 the bill and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

26 "with custody of an incident report or other record or document of a law enforcement officer
27 or agency shall not release such report or document containing any identifying information about a
28 victim of suicide, attempted suicide, rape, sexual assault, or any other sexual offense under chapter
29 566, except as authorized under subsection 4 of section 610.100."; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
32 accordingly.
