1 AMEND Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 404, Page 1, Section A, Line 1, by
2 inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "311.075. 1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter to the contrary, for the
5 purpose of the promotion of tourism, a retailer, its employees, officers, shareholders, and agents
6 may have a financial interest in a distillery for the manufacturing of intoxicating liquors located in
7 close proximity to the grounds of a recreational resort owned, in whole or in part, by the retailer, its
8 subsidiaries, or affiliates. As used in this section the term "recreational resort" shall mean any
9 grounds used to entertain guests that are owned and operated as part of a facility by the retailer, its
10 subsidiaries, or affiliates, which shall have a restaurant, at least thirty rooms for overnight
11 accommodations, and outdoor activities that include fishing or golf. The distillery shall be in close
12 proximity to the grounds of the recreational resort.

13 2. A retailer who is a holder of a license to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for
14 consumption on the recreational resort's grounds shall be exempt from the provisions of section
15 311.280, for such intoxicating liquor that is manufactured in close proximity to the grounds of the
16 recreational resort in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. All other intoxicating liquor
17 sold by the drink at retail for consumption on the recreational resort's grounds shall be obtained in
18 accordance with section 311.280.

19 3. The holder of a recreational resort distillery licensed pursuant to this section may also sell
20 intoxicating liquor produced on the distillery premises to duly licensed wholesalers, and all such
21 sales to wholesalers shall be subject to the provisions of sections 311.275 and 311.540. However,
22 holders of a recreational resort distillery license shall not, under any circumstances, directly or
23 indirectly, have any financial interest in any Missouri wholesaler's business."; and
