1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 399,
2 Page 50, Section 1, Line 7, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

5 "Section 2. 1. There is hereby established the "21st Century Missouri Transportation Task
6 Force. The mission of the task force shall be to:

7 (1) Evaluate the condition of our state transportation system, including roads and bridges;

8 (2) Evaluate current transportation funding in the state;

9 (3) Evaluate whether current transportation funding in the state is sufficient to not only

10 maintain the transportation system in its current state but also to ensure that it serves the

11 transportation needs of the citizens of this state in the twenty-first century;

12 (4) Make recommendations regarding the condition of the state transportation system; and

13 (5) Make recommendations regarding transportation funding.

14 2. The task force shall consist of the following members:

15 (1) Five members of the house of representatives, with three members to be appointed by
16 the speaker of the house of representatives, at least one of whom is a member of the joint committee
17 on transportation oversight, and two members to be appointed by the minority leader of the house of
18 representatives, at least one of whom is a member of the joint committee on transportation
19 oversight;

20 (2) Five members of the senate, with three members to be appointed by the president pro
21 tempore of the senate, at least one of whom is a member of the joint committee on transportation
22 oversight, and two members to be appointed by the minority leader of the senate, at least one of
23 whom is a member of the joint committee on transportation oversight;

24 (3) The governor or his or her designee;

25 (4) The director of the department of transportation or his or her designee;

26 (5) The director of the department of economic development or his or her designee;

27 (6) The superintendent of the state highway patrol or his or her designee; and

28 (7) Nine Missouri residents or representatives from non-governmental organizations within
29 this state, two of whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, one of
30 whom shall be appointed by the minority leader of the house of representatives, two of whom shall
31 be appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate, one of whom shall be appointed by the
32 minority leader of the senate, and three of whom shall be appointed by the governor.

33 3. The speaker of the house of representatives shall designate the chair of the task force and
34 the president pro tempore of the senate shall designate the vice chair of the task force.

35 4. The staffs of house research, senate research, and the joint committee on legislative
36 research shall provide such legal, research, clerical, technical, and bill drafting services as the task

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1 force may require in the performance of its duties.

2 5. The task force, its members, and any staff assigned to the task force shall receive
3 reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in attending meetings of the task force or
4 any subcommittee of the task force.

5 6. The task force shall hold its first meeting within two months of August 28, 2017, and
6 shall report a summary of its activities and any recommendations for legislation to the general
7 assembly no later than January 1, 2018.

8 7. The task force shall be authorized to function during the legislative interim.

9 8. The task force established under this section shall terminate on January 1, 2019."; and
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11 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
12 accordingly.
