FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** state the state board of education consists of eight members. This proposal would appoint a teacher making the board nine members.

The following chart shows total expenditures for the eight members of the board.

An average of five years yields an expenditure per board member of \$9,424. If the department assumes increased expenses of 3% per year the impact to the department would be \$9,424 in FY 2017, \$9,707 in FY 2018 and \$9,998 in FY 2019.

Oversight has recalculated the growth rate of the expenses at 2.5%. This is the standard inflation rate used annually by Oversight.

Officials at the **Missouri Senate** and the **Office of the Governor** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.
