FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Office of the Director (DPS)** state the Peace Officer Standards and Training Program within DPS already assigns an identification number to every peace officer certified in the state of Missouri.

DPS will require the addition of a Program Representative II (at \$36,924 annually) to set up the tracking system for the written complaints requirement. DPS assumes the following impact:

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Information Technology Services Division** (**DPS-ITSD**) assumed a cost to the General Revenue Fund of \$82,094 in FY 2018 as well as ongoing expense of approximately \$20,000 per year. Costs included in these estimates are 177 hours of IT consultants (at \$75 per hour), scanners, servers, Web Portal Access licenses, computers, and other expenses.

ASSUMPTION (continued)

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Office of the State Treasurer**, and the **Springfield Police Department** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC)** assume an unknown fiscal impact to the department to be less than \$100,000 annually.

Oversight assumes this proposal would not fiscally impact the MDC.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill requires the Department of Public Safety to create a law enforcement officer identification numbering system. Each law enforcement officer in Missouri will be assigned a unique identification number used to track all written complaints filed against a law enforcement officer.

The bill creates the "Law Enforcement Officer Identification Numbering System Fund." The fund will consist of moneys appropriated by the General Assembly and any grants, gifts, bequests, or donations.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
