Officials from **Crowder College, East Central College, Harris-Stowe University, Jefferson College, Kansas City, Lincoln University, Moberly Area Community College, Missouri Southern State College, Southeast Missouri State University, State Fair Community College, St. Charles Community College, St. Louis Community College, Three Rivers Community College, University of Central Missouri** and the **University of Missouri** did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
