FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **St. Louis County Board of Election Commission** assume with any one being able to vote by absentee ballot it would increase the volume of that type of voting substantially. For a county wide election this would likely increase our cost in the area by \$32,000 per election.

Officials at the **Platte County Board of Elections** estimate that this proposal would initially roughly double the number of absentee voters. This would increase election costs by approximately \$1,500 in a low turnout election like an April General Municipal or by as much as \$13,000 for the most recent presidential election, for absentee envelopes and postage.

In addition, more election judges and/or seasonal staff would be needed to handle the increased volume. In lower turnout elections this could be as low as \$200 for two additional election judges for a day. A larger election could be closer to \$3,000.

This gives a range of \$1,700 to \$16,000 per election.

In 2017, only the General Municipal is guaranteed, so 2017 costs may be \$1,700.

In 2018, we will have at least a General Municipal, Primary and General, though with less turnout than a presidential election, so 2018 costs may be \$22,000.

Officials at **Buchanan County** assume this proposal will not have a fiscal impact if they are able to place a label over the section "excuse" on the Absentee envelopes and avoid reprinting.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight assumes the number of additional individuals that qualify under this proposal would be minimal, therefore the local election authorities could cover any costs by using existing resources.

Officials at the following boards of election commission: Kansas City Board of Election Commission, St. Louis City Board of Election Commission, Clay County Board of Election Commission and Jackson County Board of Election Commission did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
