**Bill Summary:** This proposal removes restrictions on when amber or white lights may be used on motor vehicles and equipment performing work for the Department of Transportation.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Transportation, Department of Revenue, Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, Office of Prosecution Services, Office of the State Public Defender and Department of Corrections** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
