FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

For the purpose of this proposed legislation, officials at the **Office of State Public Defender** (SPD) cannot assume that existing staff will provide effective representation for any new cases arising where indigent persons are charged with the proposed new crime of labeling articles as being American Indian or craft when they are not. This offense could be punishable by 30 to 90 days incarceration. While the number of new cases may be too few or uncertain to request additional funding for this specific bill, the SPD will continue to request sufficient appropriations to provide effective representation.

Oversight assumes the SPD can absorb the additional caseload that may result from this proposal.

Officials at the **Office of the Attorney General** and the **Office of Prosecution Services** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This could have a direct fiscal impact to small businesses as a result of this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill prohibits the sale of Native American arts and crafts, and other goods represented as being Native American made, unless the arts and crafts are made by citizens or members of federally recognized Native American tribes. Any merchant who knowingly violates this provision shall be subject to a fine up to \$200 and 90 days in prison.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
