Officials at the **Office of Administration (OA)** assume OA-ITSD services will be required to create a simple website with limited storage at a cost of \$4,860 (64.80 hours x \$75 per hour) in FY 2018 to implement this proposal.

Oversight assumes OA is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes OA could absorb the costs related to this proposal.

Officials from the Office of the Secretary of State, Missouri Senate and Department of Revenue (DOR) each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
