ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Revenue** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight notes this proposal defines the term "food" but does not change that cash or food can be donated to earn the tax credit. The food panty tax credit has a \$1,250,000 annual cap. This proposal would not have an additional fiscal impact.
