Subject: Health and Senior Services Department; Dentists

Bill Summary: This proposal specifies that cone beam computed tomography (CBCT) systems and panoramic x-ray systems shall not be inspected more frequently than every six years.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

This proposal may result in minimal administrative savings on small business dentists and veterinary offices. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
