FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill authorizes the Department of Natural Resources to acquire property within the city of Kinloch, Missouri to establish the Historic Kinloch State Park and establishes the "Historic Kinloch State Park Fund" to be used, upon appropriation, for the purchase, maintenance, preservation, and improvement of the state park.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
