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#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Budget and Planning (BAP)** assume this proposal would allow the collector to use his/her judgment regarding the timeliness of property tax payments, thus possibly increasing or decreasing the penalties assessed. BAP officials assume this could impact the amount going into the County School Fund (and ultimately the school districts), but would not impact State funds.

Officials from the Department of Revenue, the State Tax Commission, Callaway County, St. Louis County, the City of Kansas City, the Jackson County Election Board, the Greene County Collector of Revenue, the Platte County Board of Elections, and the St. Louis County Directors of Elections, assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State**, and the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules**, assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal would codify existing practice and would have no fiscal impact on the state or on local governments.
