House Amendment 1

Oversight notes this amendment adds Section 304.170 which address vehicle lengths and widths allowed on Missouri highways. It also allows agricultural machinery and implements to be operated on state highways between the hours of sunset and sunrise for agricultural purposes as long as proper lighting is utilized.
