#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** assume the proposal would require the program administrator to provide financial assistance to allow individuals whose household income is at or below seventy-five percent of the federal poverty level to obtain hearing aids.

There are an estimated 87,000 people who are both hard of hearing and household income eligible to meet the terms of this proposal. The average cost of a pair of hearing aids is 2,000. Therefore, the potential cost can be calculated as follows:  $87,000 \times 2,000 = 174,000,000$ 

This cost represents the potential cost if full financial assistance is provided to eligibles. The proposal does not indicate the level of financial assistance; therefore, the cost is unknown.

**Oversight** assumes the hearing aids financial assistance will be paid out of the Deaf Relay Service and Equipment Distribution Program Fund (0559). Money collected by local exchange telephone companies are transferred into this fund. The table below shows the amount of receipts into this fund and ending balances over the past 3 years.

Since the level of financial assistance as well as the number of individuals who might apply for hearing aids are unknown, **Oversight** will reflect a negative unknown cost to the Deaf Relay Service and Equipment Distribution Program Fund.

This bill allows the program administrator of the statewide telecommunications equipment distribution program to provide financial assistance to allow individuals whose household income is 75% of the federal poverty level, or less, to obtain hearing aids.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
