### ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** assume this legislation could have a negative fiscal impact on the City. For instance, the City would be prohibited from imposing a special tax on water sold in plastic bottles.

**Oversight** inquired the City of Kansas City regarding this proposal. There is no current special tax on water sold in plastic bottles. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a \$0 fiscal impact for this proposal.

Officials at the **Office of Administration**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Natural Resources** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Office of the Attorney General** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at **Callaway County**, **Clinton County**, the **Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District** and **St. Louis County** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective organization.
