FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** assume this legislation could have a negative fiscal impact on the City. For instance, the City would be prohibited from imposing a special tax on water sold in plastic bottles.

Oversight inquired the City of Kansas City regarding this proposal. There is no current special tax on water sold in plastic bottles. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a \$0 fiscal impact for this proposal.

Officials at the **Office of Administration**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Natural Resources** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Office of the Attorney General** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at **Callaway County**, **Clinton County**, the **Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District** and **St. Louis County** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective organization.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
