In response to a previous version, officials at **St. Louis County** and the **Callaway County Commission** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

#### Bill as a whole

Officials at the **City of Independence** assume a loss in revenues of \$138,000.

Officials at the **Department of Economic Development** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the City of Kansas City assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

**Oversight** assumes there could be other cities and counties who charge a fee on interior inspections of private residences through their local ordinances. However, Oversight is unclear on the number of cities and counties in the state who charge this fee. Therefore, Oversight will assume a loss in revenues of greater than \$100,000 for this proposal.

# FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

# FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill prohibits a city or county from adopting or enforcing a residential property licensing ordinance that includes a requirement for periodic interior inspections of privately-owned residential property for city or county code violations. An occupant of privately-owned residential housing may request a city or county inspection at any time to determine code violations.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
