AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to poaching, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 252.042, to read as follows:

252.042. 1. In addition to the penalties provided in section 252.040, any person convicted of chasing, pursuing, taking, transporting, killing, processing, or disposing of wildlife in violation of methods, seasons, and limits as defined and permitted by commission rules and regulations may be required to provide restitution to the state in an amount as follows:

- 6 (1) Seven hundred fifty dollars for each wild turkey;
 - (2) One thousand five hundred dollars for each white-tailed deer; and
- 8 (3) Three thousand five hundred dollars for each black bear or elk.
- 9 2. Moneys collected under this section shall be transferred to the state school

10 moneys fund as established in section 166.051 and distributed to the public schools of this

11 state in the manner provided in section 163.031.
