	WHEREAS, St. Louis City's Medium Security Institution, also known as "the
2	Workhouse", has been in operation on Hall Street since the mid-1960s; and
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4 5	WHEREAS, over the years, there have been numerous reports and news stories regarding problems with the Medium Security Institution; and
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7 8 9	WHEREAS, of those reports and news stories, there have been many complaints regarding the physical conditions of the Medium Security Institution, with one person describing it as deplorable; and
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11 12 13	WHEREAS, other complaints regarding the physical conditions of the Medium Security Institution include cold temperatures inside the facility during cold Missouri winters and black mold, which could impose many health hazards; and
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15 16	WHEREAS, in addition to the deteriorating physical conditions, there have been numerous complaints regarding medical care within the Medium Security Institution; and
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18 19 20	WHEREAS, in an investigative report by a news station, an inmate of the Medium Security Institution attempted to obtain medical attention after being struck in the head; however, such inmate was not given adequate treatment and ultimately lost his hearing; and
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22 23	WHEREAS, in 2012, there was an ACLU settlement over alleged "deliberate indifference to a serious medical condition" for an HIV-positive inmate; and

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24 25	WHEREAS, numerous inmates have escaped from the Medium Security Institution, with one inmate using nunchucks he made from prison-issued bed sheets; and
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27 28	WHEREAS, there have been reports regarding guards forcing inmates to fight, which some have described as "gladiator-style" fighting within the facility; and
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30 31	WHEREAS, a lawsuit was brought against two guards who allegedly orchestrated and watched two inmates fight on a surveillance camera; and
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33 34	WHEREAS, at least one of those guards pled guilty to third-degree assault for the altercation between the inmates; and
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36 37	WHEREAS, seven correctional officers were fired from an incident in 2013 for violating the code of ethics for exceeding the use of force; and
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45 46	WHEREAS, according to a 2013 United States Justice Report, the Medium Security Institution had one of the highest rates of sexual misconduct among jails in the country; and
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48 49	WHEREAS, such report was based on a survey given to inmates within the Medium Security Institution, in which two hundred twenty inmates responded; and
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51 **WHEREAS**, of those inmates that responded, the United States Justice Report found that 52 6.3 percent of inmates in the Medium Security Institution have been sexually victimized:

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54 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri House 55 of Representatives, Ninety-ninth General Assembly, First Regular Session, hereby urge the City 56 of St. Louis and the city's Division of Corrections to close the Medium Security Institution; and

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58 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of 59 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the 60 Mayor of the City of St. Louis, the Director of Public Safety for the City of St. Louis, and the 61 President of the Board of Aldermen for the City of St. Louis.

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
