## AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to government transparency.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 67.2730, to read as follows:

- 67.2730. 1. A county or municipality located in this state shall establish and maintain a government website accessible to the public. A county or municipality may hire an outside entity to build or maintain the website.
- 4 2. A county or municipality shall update its government website monthly.
- 5 3. Every county and municipality shall, at a minimum, provide the following 6 information on its government website:
  - (1) The most recent financial report of the county or municipality;
- 8 (2) All ordinances, codes, and regulations in effect in the county or municipality;
- 9 (3) The most recently adopted budget of the county or municipality;
- 10 (4) Financial records regarding the total debt of the county or municipality;
- 11 (5) Financial records relating to any tax abatement programs including, but not
- 12 limited to, tax increment financing, tax development districts, and community 13 improvement districts;
  - (6) An archive of past agendas and meeting minutes of the governing body of the county or municipality;
- 16 (7) Information on the elected officials and governmental staff of the county or 17 municipality including, but not limited to:

18 (a) The name, title, and official contact information of each elected official and 19 governmental staff member; and

- (b) The date when an elected official's term ends;
- The name, title, and official contact information of the county's or 21 municipality's custodian of records; 22
  - (9) Hours of operation of the offices of the county or municipality;
  - (10) If a court resides in the county or municipality, the hours of operation of the court and the names of the presiding judge and, if applicable, city attorney or prosecutor;
  - (11) The time and location of the next board or council meeting of the county or municipality; and
  - (12) The contact information for the police and fire departments in the county or municipality.
  - 4. The office of administration shall create, maintain, and make available to counties and municipalities a website template that counties and municipalities may use to fulfill the requirements of this section.
- 5. This section shall not apply to any county or municipality with an annual budget less than five hundred thousand dollars. 34
