## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 253, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the establishment of a state park.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 253, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 253.590, to read as follows:

253.590. 1. Under the provisions of article III, section 48 of the Constitution of Missouri, the department of natural resources is hereby authorized to acquire by purchase, grant, gift, donation, devise, or bequest property located in a city of the fourth classification with more than two hundred eighty-five but fewer than three hundred twenty inhabitants and located in any county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants for the establishment of the "Historic

Kinloch State Park", to be operated and maintained by the division of state parks.

2. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Historic Kinloch State Park Fund", which shall consist of moneys appropriated to such fund and any moneys collected by gift, donation, devise, or bequest to such fund under this section. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, moneys in the fund shall be used solely for the administration of this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080, to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same

manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

- 3. Subject to appropriations, the division of state parks is authorized to use moneys
- 20 in the fund for the acquisition of property and for the maintenance, preservation, and
- 21 improvement of the state park established under this section.
