### AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to home school students.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 167.197, to read as follows:

- 3       **167.197. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:**
- 4       **(1) "Eligible student", a student who is receiving instruction through a home**
- 5 **school, as defined in section 167.031;**
- 6       **(2) "School of residence", the public school in whose attendance area an eligible**
- 7 **student resides.**
- 8       **2. The school of residence of an eligible student shall provide the eligible student**
- 9 **with the opportunity to participate in any extracurricular activity offered by such school**
- 10 **in the same manner it provides the opportunity to enrolled students.**
- 11       **3. An eligible student who seeks to participate or who participates in an activity on**
- 12 **behalf of a public school is subject to the relevant policies that apply to students enrolled**
- 13 **in the public school including, but not limited to, policies regarding registration, age**
- 14 **eligibility, fees, insurance, transportation, physical condition, qualifications,**
- 15 **responsibilities, event schedules, standards of behavior, and performance, in addition to**
- 16 **the home instruction academic and attendance requirements as described in section**
- 17 **167.031.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

18           **4. Except as otherwise provided in this section, no school or school district shall**  
19 **impose rules or fees on eligible students that differ from or exceed those that apply to other**  
20 **students participating in the same extracurricular activity.**
