**AN ACT**

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to intoxicating liquor licensees.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 311.367, to read as follows:

**311.367. 1. The provisions of this section shall apply to all persons, firms, or  
2 corporations who own and operate more than one premises licensed to sell intoxicating  
3 liquor containing alcohol in excess of five percent by weight at retail.**

**4 2. Any person, firm, or corporation described in subsection 1 of this section, with  
5 the permission of the supervisor of liquor control, may designate one or more places in this  
6 state as a central warehouse to which intoxicating liquors, except beer and other  
7 intoxicating malt liquor, ordered and purchased by a person, firm, or corporation from  
8 licensed wholesalers in this state may be delivered by licensed wholesalers in this state and  
9 at which intoxicating liquors so owned by a person, firm, or corporation may be stored.**

**10 3. Any person, firm, or corporation described in subsection 1 of this section who  
11 owns and stores intoxicating liquors in a central warehouse may transfer all or any part  
12 of the intoxicating liquors, except beer and other intoxicating malt liquor, so stored from  
13 the central warehouse in this state to any premises licensed to sell intoxicating liquors at  
14 retail which is owned and operated by the same person, firm, or corporation and which is  
15 located in the state.**
