AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to motor vehicle license plates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 301.127, to read as follows:

301.127. 1. There is hereby established an advisory committee for the department of revenue, which shall exist solely to investigate the feasibility of allowing motor vehicle owners the option of displaying one license plate on the rear of a vehicle and affixing a bumper sticker on the front of such vehicle in lieu of the two license plate requirement established under subsection 5 of section 301.130. The advisory committee's study shall include an investigation into the potential costs of and the technology needed for implementation of a bumper sticker option, and include consideration of production facility requirements and security needed for such implementation.

2. The advisory committee shall consist of the director of revenue or his or her designee, the superintendent of the highway patrol, the correctional enterprises administrator, the director of the department of transportation, and the respective chairpersons of both the senate and the house of representatives transportation commission. The advisory committee shall meet, select a chairperson from among its members, and release a report of its findings to the general assembly no later than December 31, 2017. The advisory committee shall be dissolved upon completion of its duties under this section.
