HB 93 -- MISSOURI WORKS

SPONSOR: Lauer

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Workforce Development by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 12 to 0.

This bill provides that financial assistance, through the Missouri Works Training Program, may be provided to an association of a majority of qualified companies organized to provide common training to the association members' employees.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will allow small businesses to pool together to use the Missouri Works training program. This will better distribute the funds that are already available for the workforce training program.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Lauer; Missouri Association For Career And Technical Education; Greater Kansas City Chamber Of Commerce; Missouri Community College Association; and Missouri Chamber Of Commerce and Industry.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.

This bill is the same as HB 2499 (2016).
