

HB 367 -- SEXUAL ASSAULT POLICIES

SPONSOR: Newman

This bill establishes the "Enough is Enough Act" which requires all higher education institutions to comply with Sections 1681 to 1688 of Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and shall employ at least one person, for every 20,000 students, to investigate Title IX complaints.

In addition, the institutions' sexual assault policies shall contain an affirmative consent standard to determine whether the parties consented to sexual activity and specify that no student who reports, in good faith, a sexual assault incident shall be subject to discipline for violation of any drug or alcohol policy in relation to the incident.

This bill is the same as HB 2204 (2016).
