HB 571 -- FEES FOR EXPLOSIVES USE

SPONSOR: Engler

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on General Laws by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 11 to 0.

Currently, the authorized fee for explosives use cannot exceed \$2 per ton. This bill increases the limit to \$7.50 per ton. The fee established by rule cannot exceed the cost of administering the Missouri Blasting Safety Act.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this allows for a reasonable increase to account for administrative oversight.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Engler; Missouri Limestone Producers Association; and Edward Twehous, Twehous Excavating Company, Inc..

OTHERS: Others testifying on the bill say that the Division of Fire Safety, within the Department of Public Safety, does have administrative costs associated with overseeing the provisions of the Act.
