HB 589 -- PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX

SPONSOR: Mathews

This bill adds certain cities to the list of cities authorized to impose, upon voter approval, a sales tax of up to 0.5% for public safety purposes, including expenditures on equipment, city employee salaries and benefits, and facilities for police, fire, and emergency medical providers.

The additional cities include the City of Eureka, Town & County, and Bellefontaine Neighbors.

The bill specifies that any sales tax imposed by the additional cities will automatically expire on December 31, 2038.
