

HB 742 -- POSSESSION OF FIREARMS

SPONSOR: McCreery

This bill modifies the categories of persons who cannot possess firearms so that Missouri law conforms with federal law. Under this bill, any person who has been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence, any person who is illegally or unlawfully in the United States, any person who was once a United States citizen but has renounced that citizenship, or any person subject to certain court orders relating to domestic violence cannot possess a firearm.

The bill does not remove any of the existing categories of persons who cannot possess firearms.

This bill is the same as SB 318 (2017).
