

HB 764 -- TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES

SPONSOR: Marshall

This bill specifies that a Transportation Network Company (TNC) and TNC driver shall not be considered common carriers, contract carriers, motor carriers, taxicabs, or for-hire vehicles and will not be required to register as or meet any requirements therefore. The bill states that TNC drivers will be independent contractors and not employees, except under certain circumstances. This bill requires a TNC to maintain an agent for service of process in the state of Missouri.

This bill does not require TNC drivers to obtain any special state or local license and will not be required to pay any tax. The bill does not include any licensing or permitting requirement for a TNC to operate within the state and it does not require a TNC to perform any criminal background check before allowing an individual to become a TNC driver.
