

HB 782 -- PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS AND CIRCUIT ATTORNEYS RETIREMENT
SYSTEM

SPONSOR: Rowland (155)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on
Pensions by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill exempts certain counties from the monthly payment to the
Prosecuting Attorneys and Circuit Attorneys Retirement Fund for any
month the county does not have a prosecuting attorney or circuit
attorney employed.

Currently, this section includes Ozark County.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill will exempt certain
counties from making the monthly payment to the retirement system
when they don't have a prosecuting attorney employed. It is not
fair that we have to make that payment when we have no prosecutor.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Rowland and County
Commissioners Association.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
