

HCS HB 915 -- POST TRAUMATIC STRESS AWARENESS DAY

SPONSOR: Ruth

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS by Consent" by the Special Committee on Tourism by a vote of 10 to 0. Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Committee on Consent and House Procedure.

This bill designates June 27 of each year as "Post Traumatic Stress Awareness Day" in Missouri and encourages citizens to observe the day through activities which will increase awareness of post traumatic stress.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill would bring awareness to post traumatic stress, which can be caused by many traumatic events.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Ruth.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
